Claims survey starts!

The collective agreement in the public sector (TVöD) expires at the end of the year. The survey is now starting at Charité, Vivantes and JKB. Now it's your turn!

In recent months, hundreds of thousands of colleagues have taken part in the nationwide working time survey. This has shown how high the workload and pressure are in the public sector.

Now the question is what you want to demand for the upcoming wage negotiations in the public sector. Are you in favor of demanding higher wages or do you think the issue of working hours is particularly important? Or both?

Build strength!

The last rounds of collective bargaining have shown that the more you unite and strike together, the higher the probability that you will be able to enforce your demands. Only if many colleagues get involved, take responsibility for organizing the collective bargaining movement for their areas and organize themselves, can you not only make high demands, but also enforce them.



What are the next steps?

The claims survey runs until September 23rd.

On October 2nd, the Berlin-wide demands conference will take place with colleagues from hospitals, the BSR, the water companies and many other companies. After that, the ver.di Federal Tariff Commission will decide on the demands that are collected from all federal states.

The collective bargaining kick-off is on October 23. Then we will start preparing for possible strikes that could take place around the negotiation dates in January-March, if necessary. Now it is up to everyone to build strength together.

How can I participate?

Every team needs active members and team delegates to conduct the interviews to determine the demands now until the end of September. You can find the most important dates and how you can register your team delegates on the back.
